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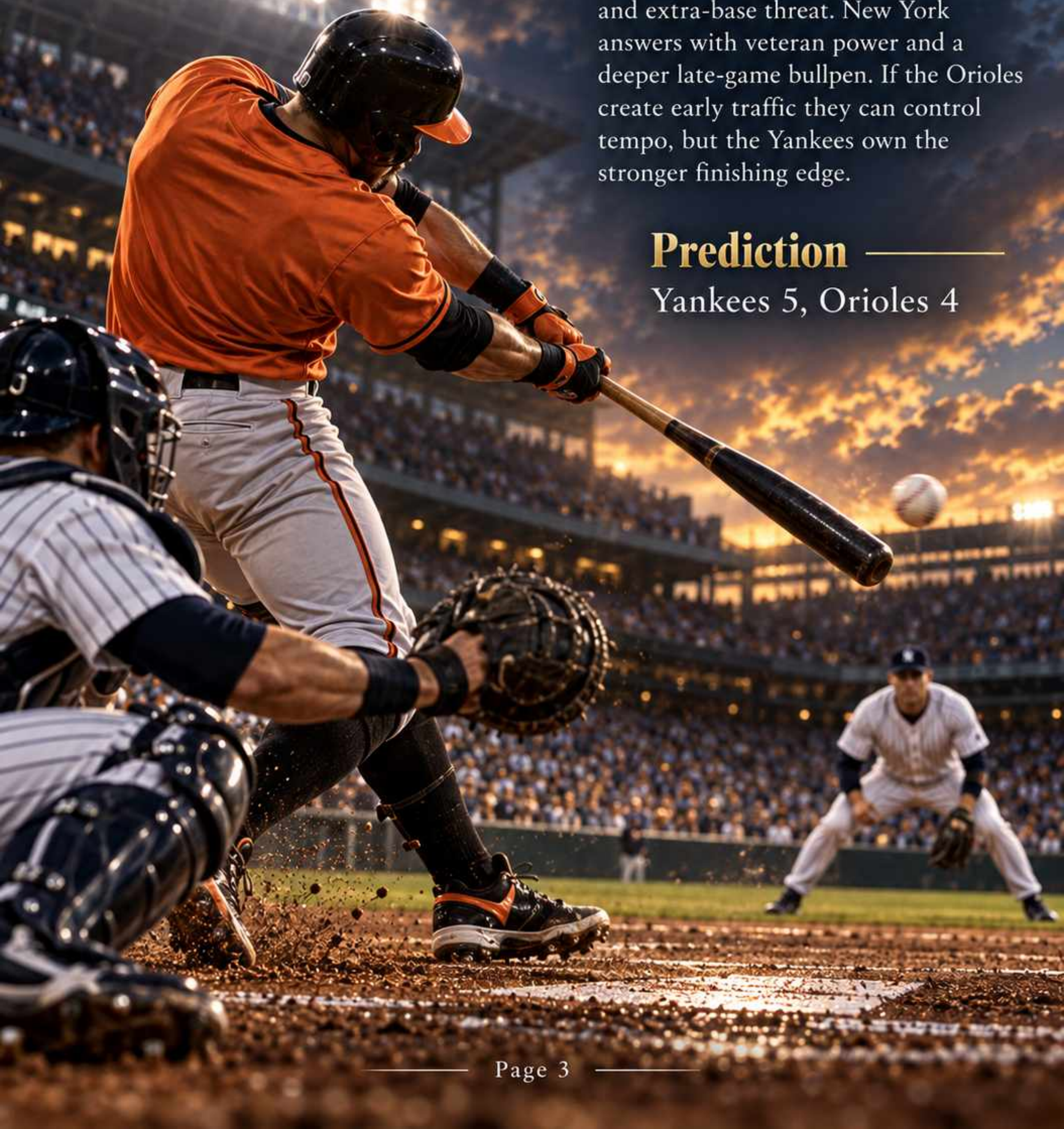
Orioles vs Yankees

Analysis

Baltimore brings speed, pressure and extra-base threat. New York answers with veteran power and a deeper late-game bullpen. If the Orioles create early traffic they can control tempo, but the Yankees own the stronger finishing edge.

Yankees 5, Orioles 4



Dodgers vs Giants

Analysis

This matchup carries playoff intensity and contrasting styles. Los Angeles has more lineup depth and steadier run creation, while San Francisco stays dangerous when its pitching controls the pace. The Dodgers hold the more complete edge over nine innings.

Prediction

Dodgers 6, Giants 3

Diamondbacks vs Padres

Analysis

Arizona can manufacture pressure with athletic baserunning and aggressive at-bats. San Diego offers the steadier star power and a stronger ability to convert key moments late. If this stays close into the final innings, the Padres have the cleaner closing profile.

Prediction

Padres 5, Diamondbacks 4



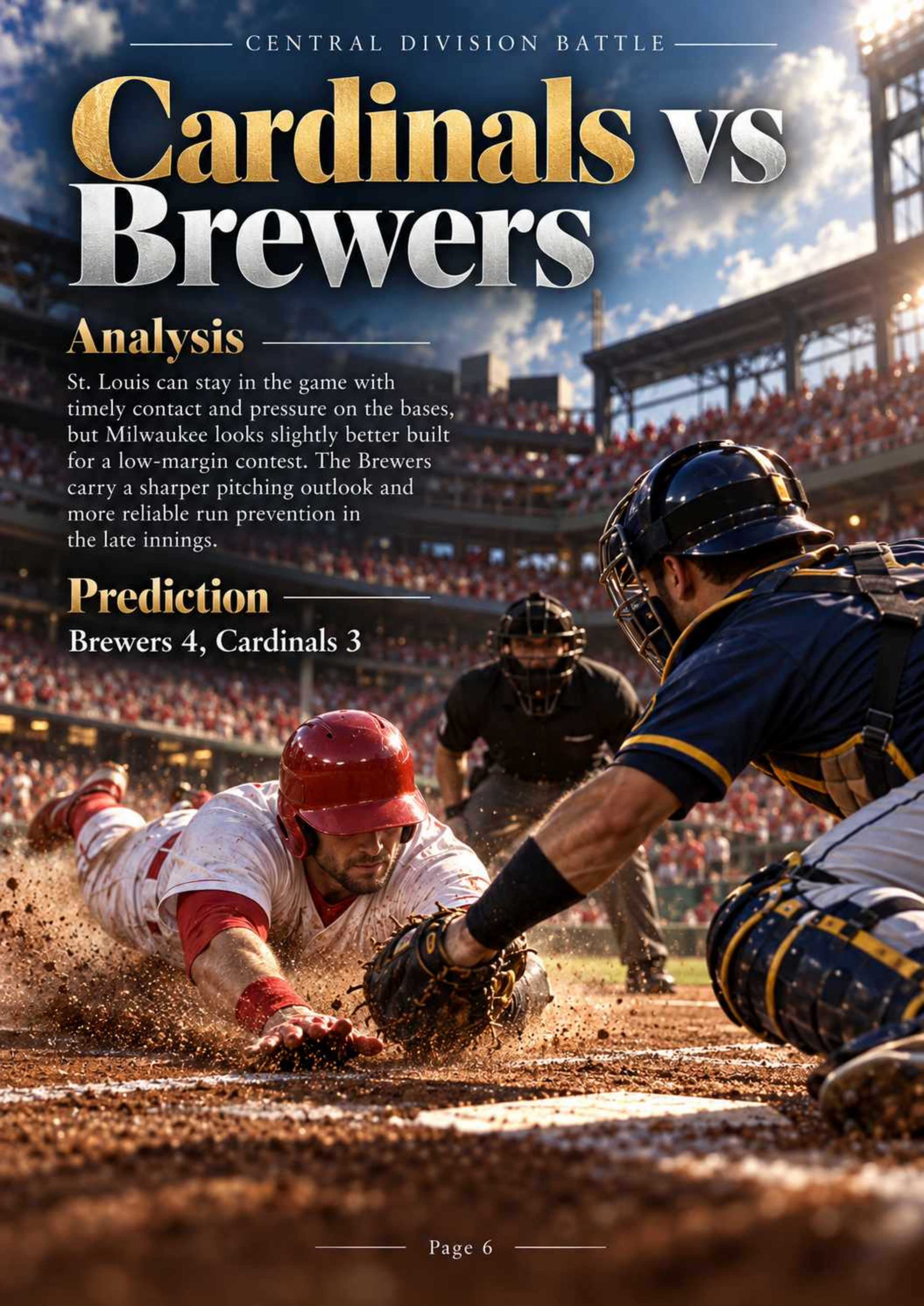
Cardinals vs Brewers

Analysis

St. Louis can stay in the game with timely contact and pressure on the bases, but Milwaukee looks slightly better built for a low-margin contest. The Brewers carry a sharper pitching outlook and more reliable run prevention in the late innings.

Prediction

Brewers 4, Cardinals 3



Cubs vs Red Sox

Analysis

Both clubs have enough offense to turn this into a momentum game. Chicago looks more capable of building innings through contact and traffic, while Boston remains dangerous if power bats cash in early. The Cubs get the nod in what should be a high-scoring battle.

Prediction

Cubs 6, Red Sox 5



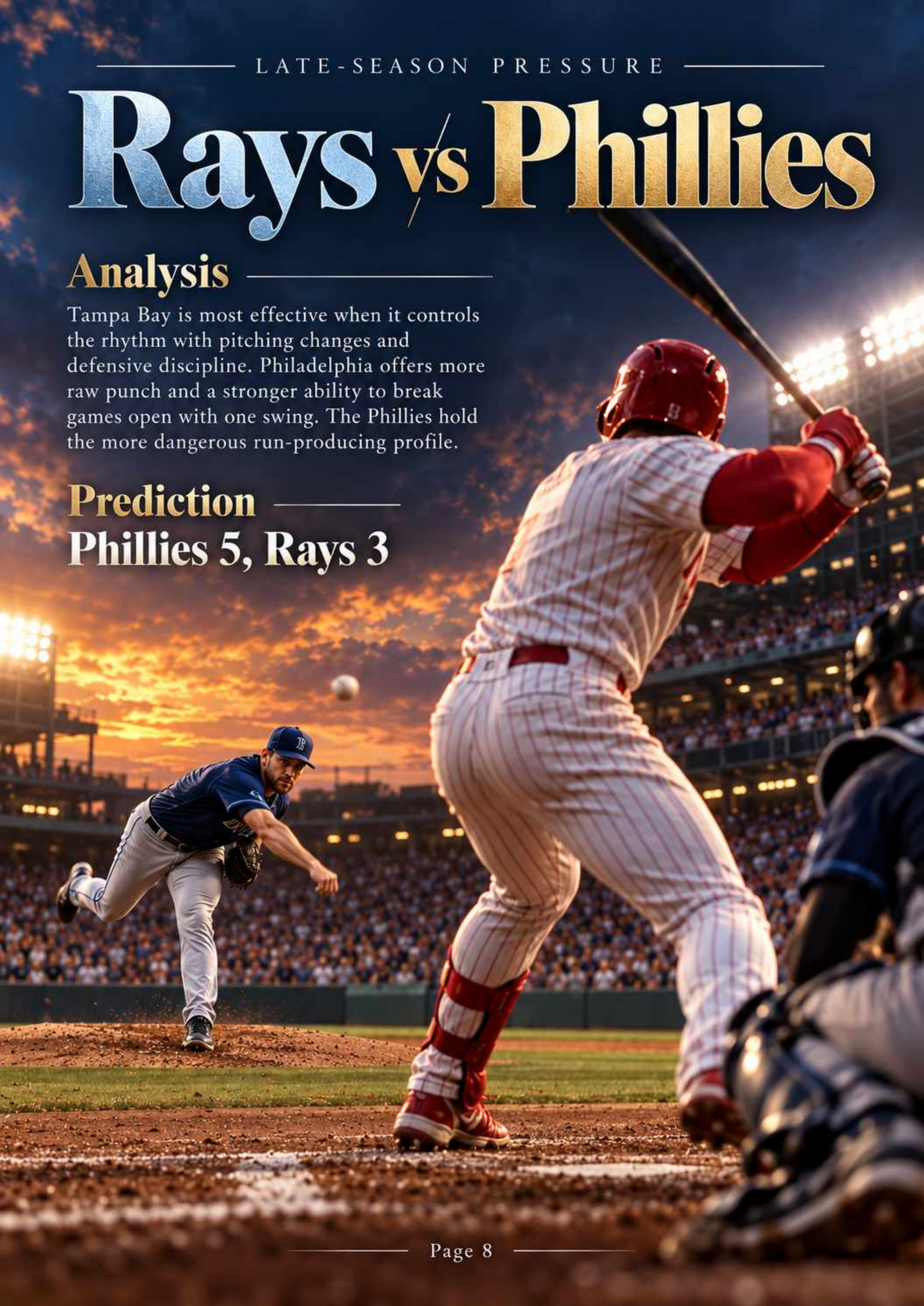
Rays vs Phillies

Analysis

Tampa Bay is most effective when it controls the rhythm with pitching changes and defensive discipline. Philadelphia offers more raw punch and a stronger ability to break games open with one swing. The Phillies hold the more dangerous run-producing profile.

Prediction

Phillies 5, Rays 3



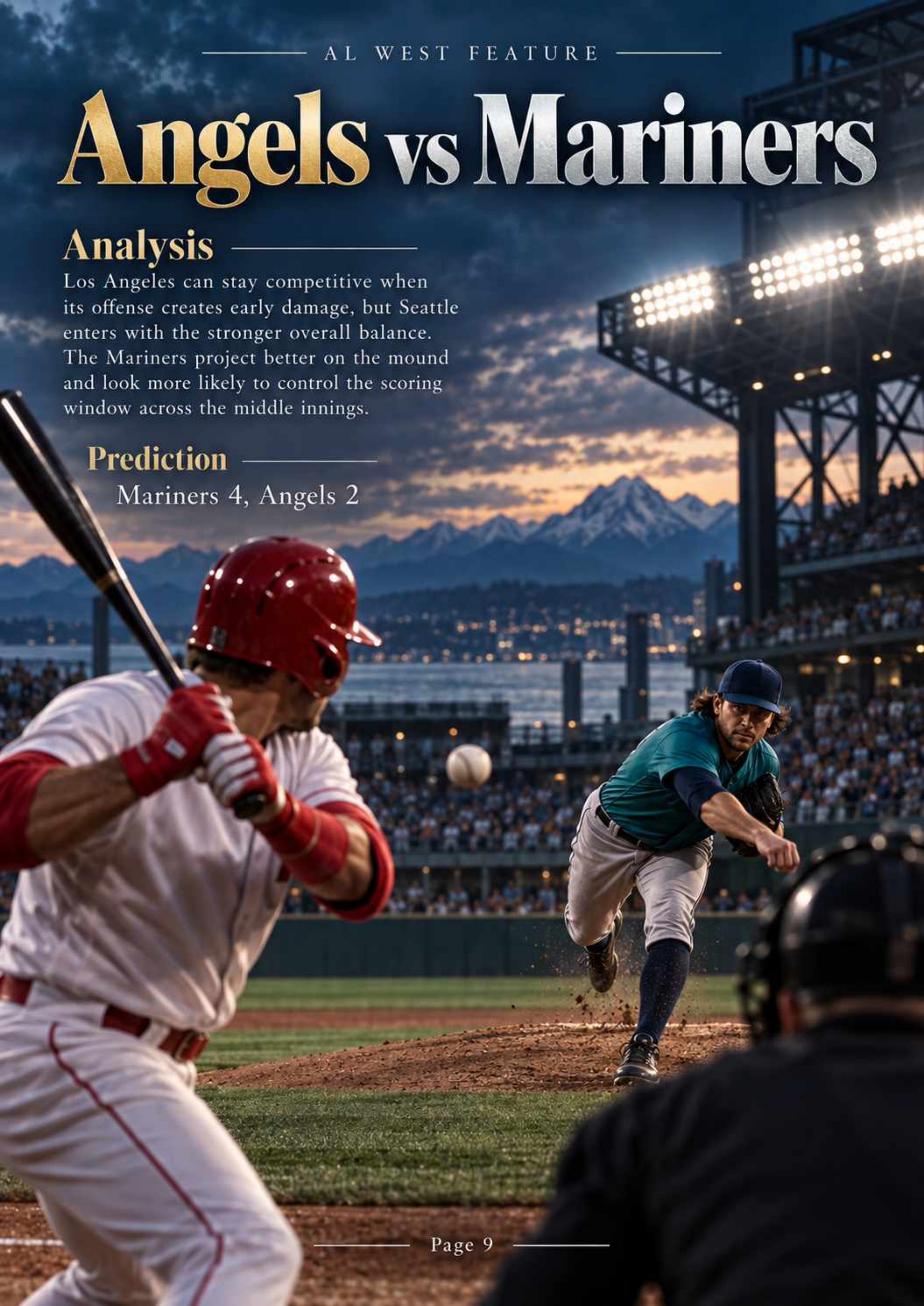
Angels vs Mariners

Analysis

Los Angeles can stay competitive when its offense creates early damage, but Seattle enters with the stronger overall balance. The Mariners project better on the mound and look more likely to control the scoring window across the middle innings.

Prediction

Mariners 4, Angels 2



Reds vs Blue Jays

Analysis

Cincinnati brings energy and scoring upside, especially if it can pressure the bases. Toronto counters with the more polished lineup structure and a steadier ability to turn chances into runs. Over a full game, the Blue Jays look better equipped to finish the job.

Prediction

Blue Jays 6, Reds 4



METS vs NATIONALS

Late-Season NL East Spotlight

New York enters the final weekend with the deeper lineup and more reliable late-inning options, while Washington needs quick run support and cleaner command to flip the pressure. The matchup leans toward the club that can control the middle innings and turn extra baserunners into crooked numbers.

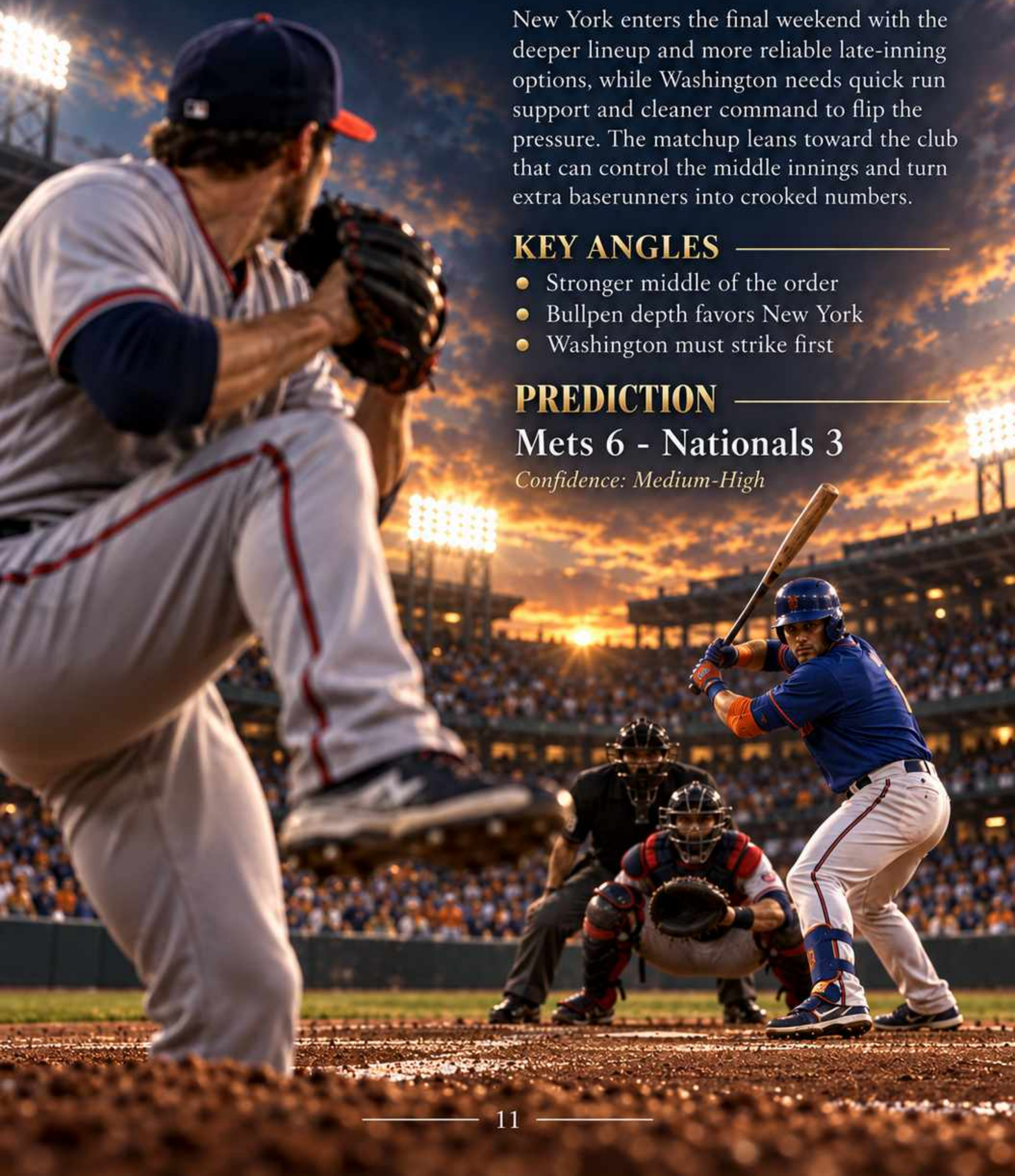
KEY ANGLES

BRAVES vs MARLINS

NL East Pressure In Miami

Atlanta brings the steadier run production and deeper late-game options, while Miami must create pressure with contact, speed and cleaner starting command. If the home side cannot keep traffic off the bases early, the matchup tilts toward the more polished lineup and bullpen.

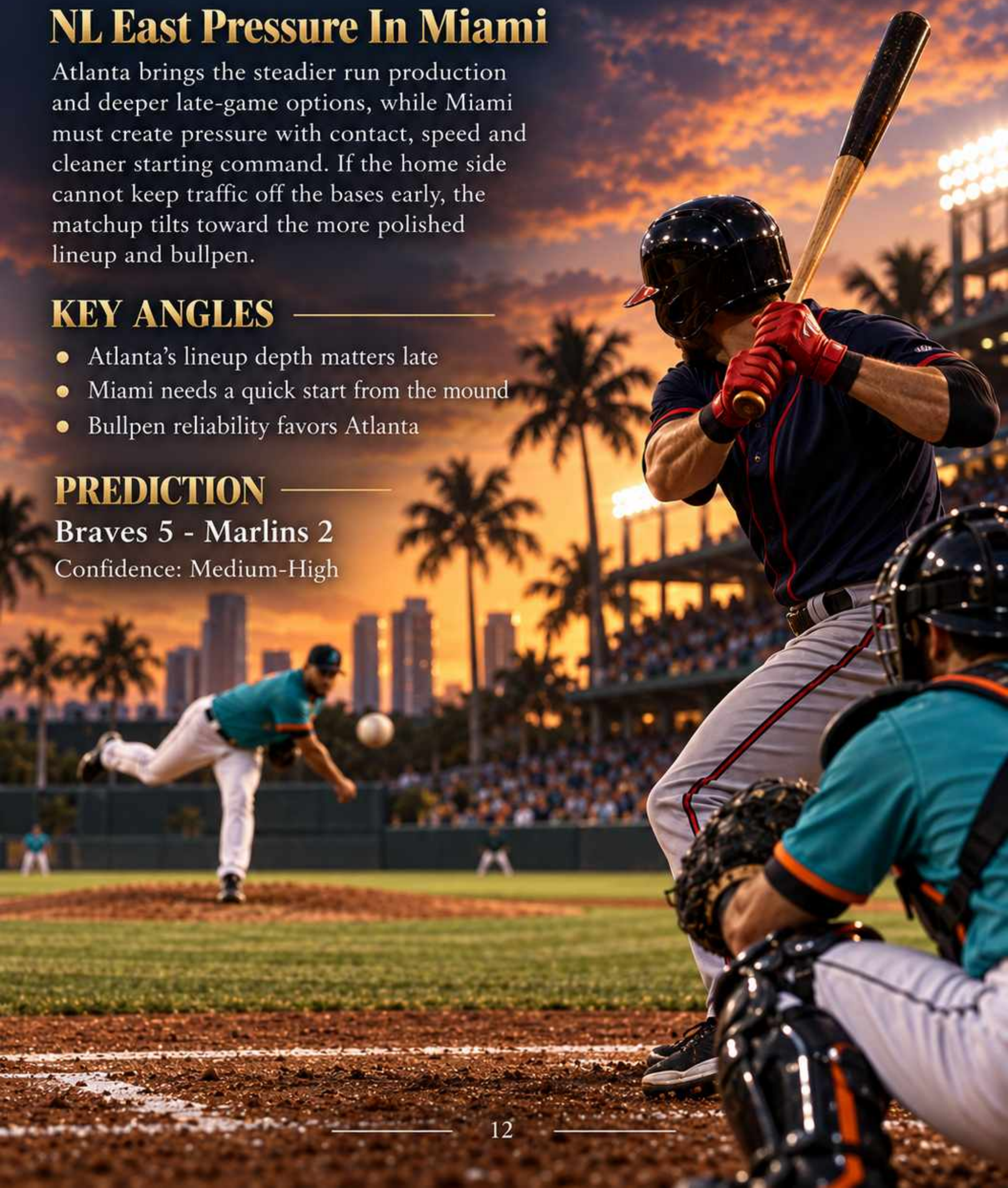
KEY ANGLES

- Miami needs a quick start from the mound
- Bullpen reliability favors Atlanta

Guardians vs Royals

AL Central Control Battle

Cleveland carries the more flexible run-prevention profile into the final weekend, while Kansas City needs timely extra-base damage to change the flow. The key matchup is whether the home side can pressure early counts and prevent Cleveland from settling into its preferred bullpen rhythm.

KEY ANGLES

- Cleveland's pitching depth travels well
- Kansas City must cash in runners in scoring position
- Bullpen execution could decide the series

PREDICTION

Guardians 4 - Royals 3

Confidence: Medium

RANGERS vs TWINS

AL Matchup With Playoff Implications

Texas brings the more explosive extra-base potential into the closing weekend, while Minnesota needs sharper situational hitting and cleaner rotation work to stay in control. This series could turn on which staff limits early damage and forces the other lineup to chase the game.

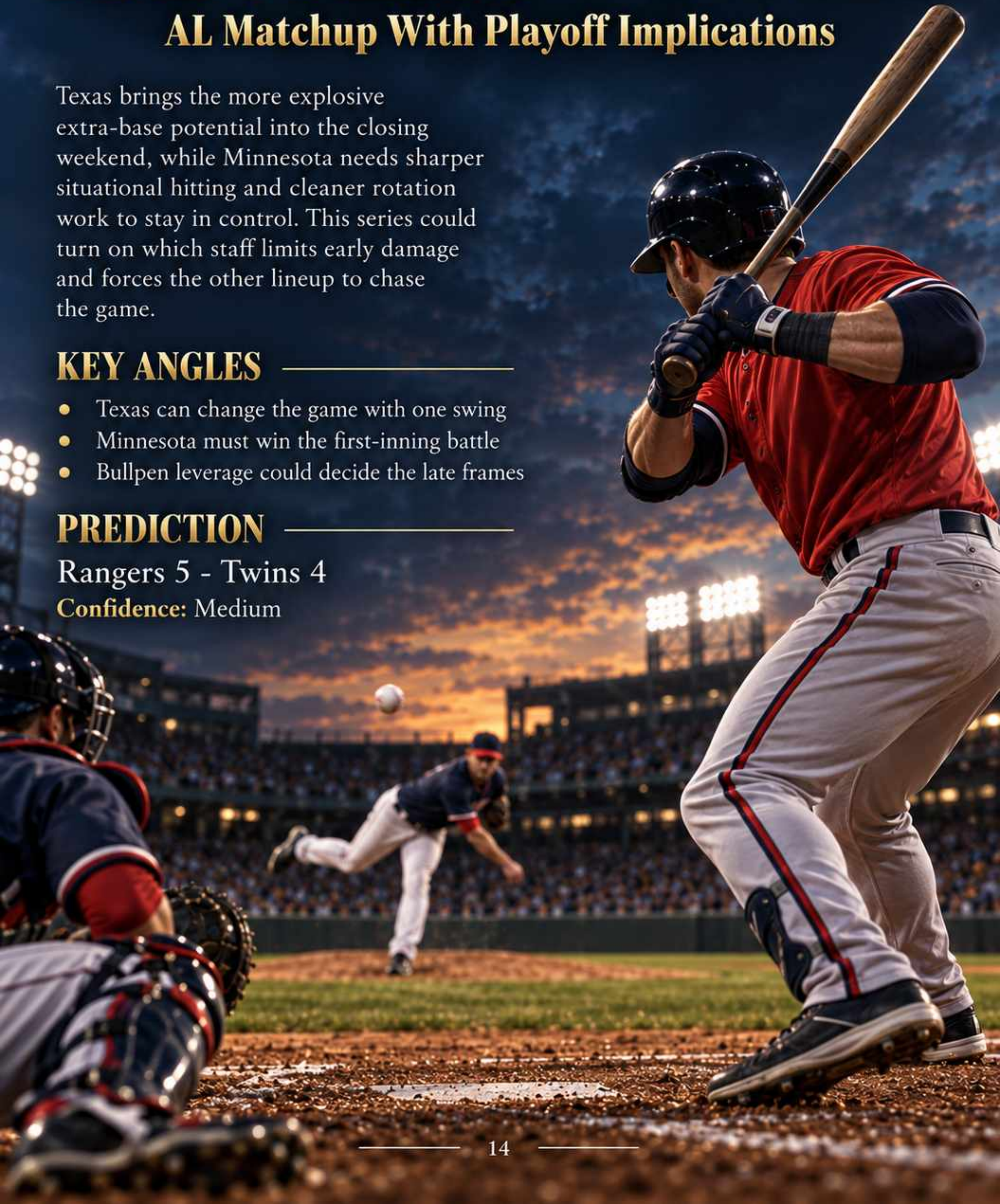
KEY ANGLES

ASTROS vs ATHLETICS

AL West Closing Weekend Battle

Houston enters the final weekend with the steadier offensive floor and more late-inning power, while Oakland needs cleaner run prevention and timely contact to keep the pressure on. The turning point may be whether the Athletics can slow Houston's baserunning pressure and force a lower-scoring game.

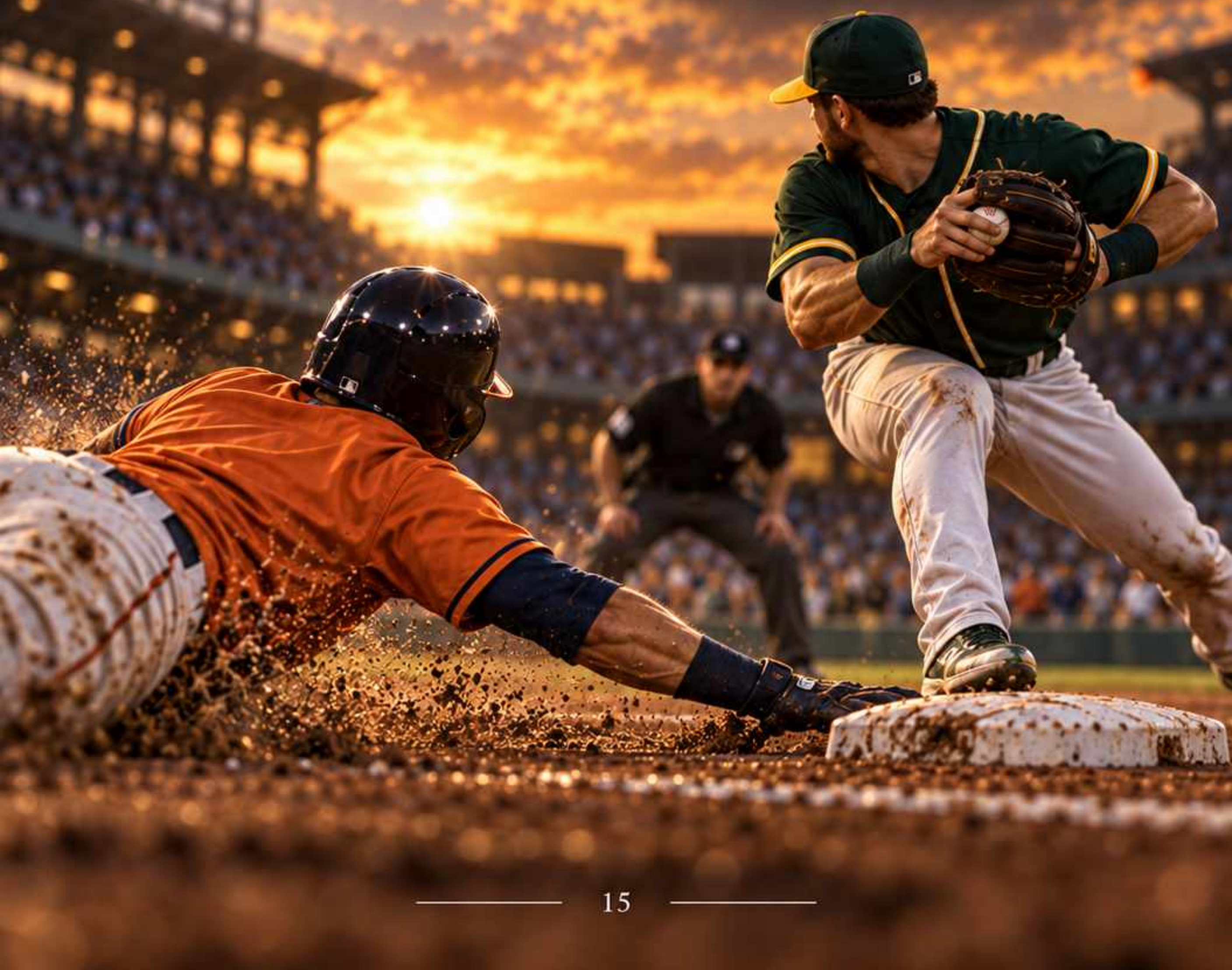
KEY ANGLES

PIRATES vs TIGERS

Interleague Pressure In Detroit

Pittsburgh needs a cleaner offensive start and more traffic on the bases, while Detroit enters the series with the steadier run-prevention profile. If the Tigers control the first few innings and avoid extra mistakes in the infield, the late-game edge stays on the home side.

KEY ANGLES

- Detroit's pitching floor looks steadier
- Pittsburgh must create early pressure
- Defense around the plate could decide tight innings

ROCKIES vs WHITE SOX

Late-Season Cross-League Test

Analysis

Colorado needs cleaner bullpen innings and timely power to stay competitive, while Chicago's edge comes from steadier run prevention and a more reliable late-game structure. If the White Sox control the strike zone early, the home side can keep the final weekend pressure manageable.

KEY ANGLES

- Chicago's pitching floor looks stronger

Final Weekend Storylines That Could Shift October

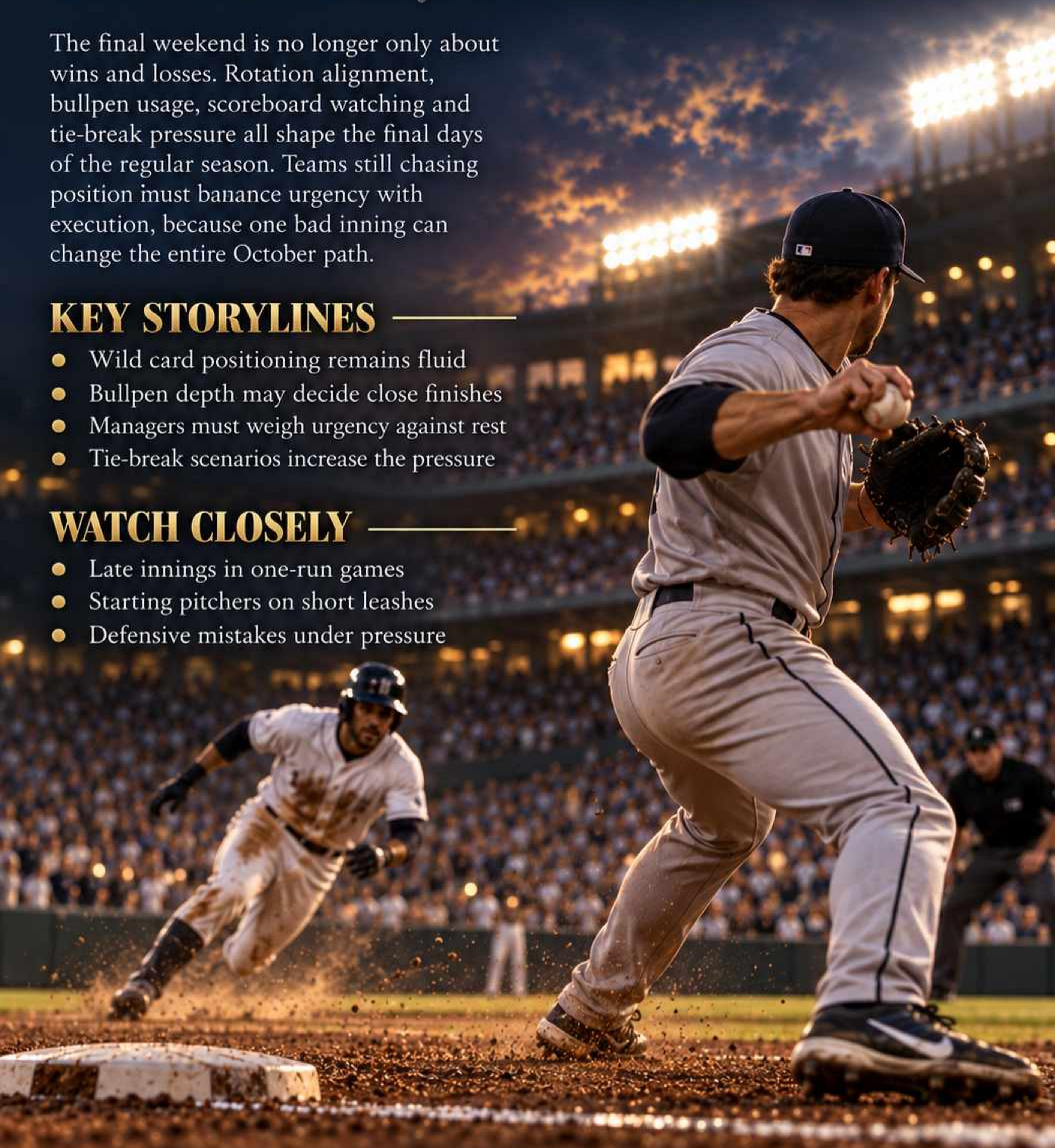
